5. John Lemke announced that he and Carl Schwanbeck were the CD6 representatives from SD31 and that the body needed to vote on whether to retain them or to elect someone new. Motion by John West with a second by Rhadja Lohse to keep John Lemke and Carl Schwanbeck as CD 6 representatives from SD31. Motion passed.

5. Kurt Daudt, Minority Leader of the state house and state representative from SD31 spoke about state issues with taxes, the governor and his emergency powers. Governor being allowed to spend billions of dollars with no legislative oversight. The legislatures have leverage with the budget and should be used to help our cause. We'll see what the outcome is. Will they fold?

6. Walter Hudson, City Council member in Albertville and radio personality spoke on evil masked as equity and how we can defeat it. 9. Mark Koran, State Senator from SD32 spoke of helping candidates that we want to get elected.

10. Cal Bahr, State Representative from SD31B spoke of getting people to fill local and county committees, how small local positions have money control.

11. Julie Braastad spoke of working to change the Northstar rail system or close it completely, backing law enforcement.

12. Sheri Bukkila, Mayor of Andover spoke about the new community center being shut down right after it was finished and what a misdirection of tax money she thought that had been. Support all city and committee members that are aligned with our views.

13. Suzanne Erkel, City Council member from East Bethel spoke of concerns about a development on Hwy 65 & 22. She feels it will destroy the East Bethel country feel.
